Abu Dhabi to Host Inaugural Edition of Climate Abu Dhabi in October 2016

Indoor Climate and Cold Chain Technologies Exhibition to Showcase Innovations and Advancements in Energy-efficient Technology

Abu Dhabi-UAE: 04 April, 2016 - The first edition of Climate Abu Dhabi, an exhibition dedicated to the heating, ventilation, air conditioning and refrigeration (HVACR) industry, will take place from 3 to 5 October at the Abu Dhabi National Exhibition Centre (ADNEC). The brand new event will focus on showcasing innovative energy-efficient building cooling technology.
